Good metal, painted by not recent, base/clear coat, top replaced. Interior replaced, we have the original front seats, but we have replaced them with modern seats with tilt adjustment (no headrest). The head lites are Quartz bulbs. Electrical system is 12 volts, with alternator. Starter rewound for 12 volts. Electrical system fused for protection. Water pump rebuilt, lubricated with water resistant grease. Engine rebuild, sleeved to standard pistons, crank balanced, B cam installed, valve job, rods and mains new Babbitt, high compression head installed. (\$3,500 cost to rebuild). Turn signals installed, third eye brake lite installed in rear window. Original 6 volt horn has a dropping resistor with relay to operate on 12 volts. Water recovery tank for radiator. After-market tubular shocks installed. Tube installed in the steering sector to prevent leaks. Filter installed in gas tank to help filter gasoline. Brakes very good, car has been well maintained. Garaged. Seat belts in front. (See Below)

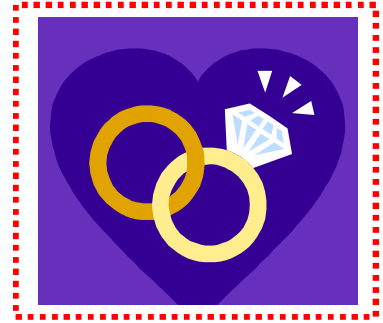


