Coats and Jackets and Ensembles 1929



I *Delineator* magazine of November 1929. Notice the many different styles available. Notice the odd skirt on model #2 and the waistline on model #4, called the “princess.” And look at model #9. Who would think to buy a coat with a matching rug? It must be to watch a football game, as we saw in the article. And look at the low hip line on model #10, which is not really a hip line at all, much too low. Also, notice the belt at the waistline on model #13. This is November 1929 and the styles are gradually going into the 1930-31 waistline styles.

Look at the hats. Notice that most of the models are wearing them showing the forehead, again showing the coming hat styles of the next year, except for models #5 and #9, and probably #14 – although you can’t see the front of the hat. They still cling to the typical 1928-1929 style. Look at the purses on models #4, #5 and #8. I cannot figure out what type of a purse or muff model #11 is carrying. Can you?

If you can sew and are clever enough to make something without a pattern, choose an outfit you like and make it for the next Meet or Fun Fashion event. Take these illustrations with you, if you are going shopping for a hat. The best bet to find a hat is at a “Textile, Costume and Clothing Show,” which periodically come to most cities. Or, if you’re really lucky, you might find one at an antique store, swap meet or estate sale. But these take a lot longer to find.

- (1) London Trades: black and white tweed over black jersey
- (2) Cheruit sponsors the “princess” in this Reseda green cloth
- (3) Molyneux creates a stunning cape frock of black crepella
- (4) Lelong: Green velvet coat with typical box plaited frill
- (5) London Trades: Burnt orange tweed suit with black caracal
- (6) Lelong makes a cape coat of tan tweed with black astrakhan
- (7) Moyneux street costume of rough pebbly tweed with nutria
- (8) Patou’s sloping pocket distinguish this black cheviot frock
- (9) Cheruit chooses duveteen for basque blouse ensemble
- (10) Nowitsky double-faced tweed coat with jersey frock
- (11) Schiaparelli uses double crossed bands in this blue coat
- (12) Chanel presents the cape coat in green jersey tweed
- (13) Schiaparelli uses black tweed coat over blue knicker skirt
- (14) Schiaparelli design a plaid tweed coat with rug to match
