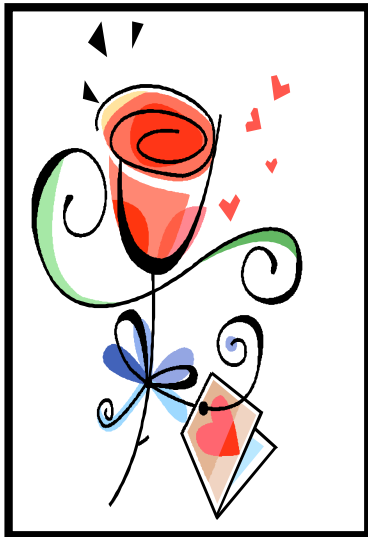
Hi Guys;
